
Children's Mobile Phone Permission

Children should only bring their mobile phones into school if they are walking to school alone, or walking home alone and they need to have them in case of an emergency. If your child fits the above criteria, could you please sign and return the slip below to indicate that due to safety reasons you wish your child to bring a phone into school.

Please note that your child will need to switch his/her phone off completely before entering the playground and they will need to hand their phones to the box in the classroom at the beginning of the school day.

The phones will be kept in an office during the day, to ensure that they are kept safe and avoid them being lost or damaged. For safeguarding reasons, your child will not be able to keep their phone in the classroom and they should have the slip below completed before they bring them to school.
