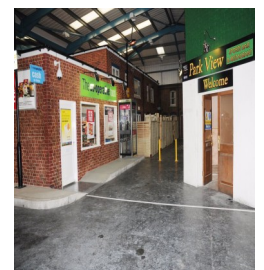
Chatsworth House Visit

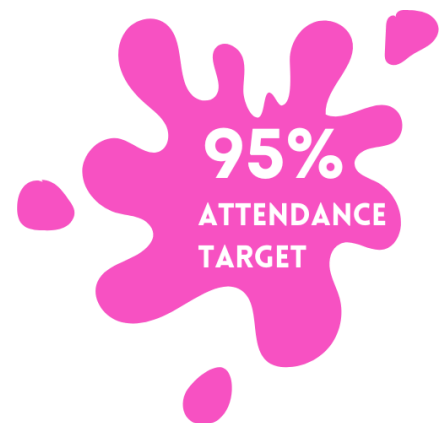

The First Steps of the Journey: Our Nursery Stars

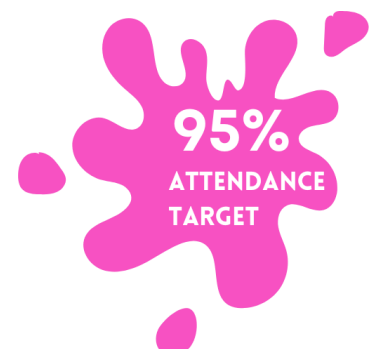

Our current Nursery attendance is sitting between 77% and 88%, and we want to work with you to turn those numbers around. Every day your child spends in Nursery is a page in the first chapter of their education story; missing these early pages makes it harder to follow the plot later on. Research shows that children who build strong attendance habits in Nursery find the transition to "big school" much easier and go on to achieve their full potential. Let's help our littlest learners build the "attendance muscles" they need to be successful, confident, and ready to shine in Reception and beyond!

With just 12 weeks of the school year remaining, we are incredibly proud of how hard our community is working to finish the year with momentum.
