

Year 6 SATs – May 2026

We are very proud of the effort being made by our Year 6 pupils as they prepare for their SATs tests, and we would like to thank you all for the support that you are giving your child with their learning.

As you know SATs week begins on Monday 11th May; we have included a timetable below for your information.

Date	Assessment Paper
Monday 11th May 2026	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar Test (SPaG) (Paper 1) Spelling Test (Paper 2)
Tuesday 12th May 2026	Reading Paper
Wednesday 13th May 2026	Maths – Paper 1 – Arithmetic Maths – Paper 2 – Reasoning
Thursday 14th May 2026	Maths – Paper 3 - Reasoning

You will note that there is no writing test. The assessment for this is completed by teachers and is based on children's writing across the year.

FREE BREAKFAST - All children will be provided with a free breakfast next week. There will be a variety of food on offer such as cereals, toast, bagels, crumpets and fruit to help the children ensure they are prepared fully for their assessments.

Y6 breakfast club will start at 8am, children should arrive at the breakfast club gate. They will eat together in the smaller side of the dining room.

We are also providing snack free of charge for all Y6 pupils during SATs week.

How you can help your child prepare for the test:

- Ensure **high attendance**
- Don't put children under too much pressure
- Ensure children arrive **on time** every morning
- Go to bed at a reasonable time (9 o'clock at the latest)
- No running club for Y6 pupils during SATs week so they can enjoy breakfast with their friends
