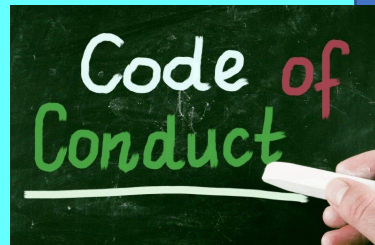


Conduct of Parents/Carers and Visitors at Kingfisher Primary  
Kingfisher Primary implements a policy for the conduct of parents, carers and visitors to the school, in conjunction with Astrea Academy Trust. It is our standard practice to allow parents permission at certain times of the day to bring and collect their child and to be on school premises. However, this is always on condition that the visitors' behaviour is reasonable and inoffensive. Should any parent or visitor act in an unreasonable manner to any member of our school community, permission for them to be on the school site will be withdrawn and further action taken if necessary.



## Uniform

Firstly, I would just like to say thank you to all our families—the children have come back to school very smart and with the correct uniform. The children are spoken proudly about their new shoes and new jumpers. I know that this is a significant cost for everyone and whilst we stress to the children about taking responsibility for their jumpers when they take them off, inevitably children put jumpers down leave them and then don't know where they have put them. It has been difficult reuniting children to their clothing as so much of what we already have in lost property does not have names in. This is a plea on schools behalf, please could you put your child's name in the item of clothing and then if it does get misplaced it is easy to return it to the child.

### Parents' Evening

There will be the opportunity on **Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> October** between **3.15pm** and **7.00pm** to discuss the academic and social progress being made by your child(ren) with their class teacher.

We will be continuing to offer the option of coming into school to meet with your child's class teacher face to face or offering you the opportunity to receive this information through a telephone conversation. You will be able to indicate on the letter coming out after half term what your preference is.



### Universal Free School Meals

Please can we remind you that if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 they are entitled to receive universal school meals.

This is a scheme set up by the Government that offers a free meal to all infant children. The school kitchen serves a wide variety of meals to suit everyone's taste and everyday there are four choices on the school dinner menu including a vegetarian, jacket potato and sandwich choice.

However, you must still sign up on the Doncaster Council website if you believe that your child would be entitled to Free School Meals due to your financial position. I would encourage you to do this as there are different offers given by Doncaster Council for children during the holidays and you will only receive them if you have applied through the Doncaster Council website.



### Holidays in Term Time



The law states that children should not be taken out of school for a holiday during term time. Term time holidays in Doncaster **will not** be authorised. If you take your child out of school without the school's permission, you may be issued with a penalty fine. Fines are issued by the Local Authority. It is really important that your child does not miss learning opportunities in school, as this can lead to gaps in their understanding making it more challenging for them as they progress through primary and into secondary school. This is not just in their academic achievements but also their confidence, ability to form and maintain friendships and their ability to build executive functions.
