Thursday 15th January 2026 is the closing date for admission forms for Reception places to be completed and submitted to the Local Authority

If you take your child out of school without the school's permission, you may be issued with a penalty fine. Fines are issued by the Local Authority. It is really important that your child does not miss learning opportunities in school, as this can lead to gaps in their understanding making it more challenging for them as they progress through primary and into secondary school. This is not just in their academic achievements but also their confidence, ability to form and maintain friendships and their ability to build executive functions.
