



Start and end of the school day

I wanted to take a moment to discuss some important matters regarding our school grounds and pupil safety. As we've observed recently, there are specific areas of our school that require careful attention and respect from both our pupils and families.

Our school field and Forest School area are designated spaces with clear guidelines about pupil access. During the school day, these areas are off-limits to children. I'm writing to emphasise the importance of maintaining these boundaries, both during school hours and outside of them.

When collecting your children, I kindly request that you ensure they do not enter or play on the school field, particularly during wet and muddy conditions. We've noticed that wet ground can lead to mud being tracked into our school, which directly impacts our carpeted corridors. Keeping these areas clean and maintaining our school environment is a collective responsibility.

Regarding our Forest School area, I want to reassure parents that we take pupil safety extremely seriously. Before any use of this space, our staff conduct thorough checks in line with our comprehensive risk assessment protocols. This ensures that the area is safe and appropriate for pupil activities.

By working together and following these guidelines, we can protect our school grounds, maintain a clean learning environment, and ensure pupil safety. At the start and end of the day these checks have not been carried out so the children should not be accessing the space.
