

Maths

During this half term, for the first two weeks, we will work on addition and subtraction of two 2-digit numbers. We will then move onto exploring shape for the rest of the half term.

Literacy

In Literacy, we will be reading History Makers - 'Henry VIII and his six wives'. This will support our history as we discover more about Henry VIII. By the end of the half term, we will have written an information text all about him.

Science

This half term we will focus on 'Animals including Humans – Offspring'. We will look at lifecycles of different animals and explain a basic human timeline.

Weather Patterns

Reading/ Phonics

Some of our children will take part in daily phonics lessons following the Read Write Inc scheme. Other children in the year group will explore a novel study, reading the text 'Gormy Ruckles Monster Trouble'.

Citizenship

Our Citizenship lessons will continue to be linked to the sustainability goals, focusing on 'Weather Patterns'. We will continue to look at the differences between types of weather and types of disasters.

Geography

We will be learning more about the British Isles. We will then compare our local area with Cape Town in South Africa.

DT

We will be focusing on Food Technology – creating a healthy packed lunch (sandwich and sweet treat).

History

We are continuing to learn all about the Tudors. We have learnt about Henry VIII and why he is so famous, so this half term we will explore how the changes he made have impacted England today.
