Introduction

At Astrea Academy Sheffield we have high expectations of our scholars and we believe that scholars should wear their uniform with pride throughout the school day. Astrea Academy Sheffield has carefully selected smart but affordable uniform that can be purchased through Logo leisurewear (www.logoleisurewear.com) and My School Gear for PE kit (https://astrea-academy.myschoolgear.co.uk/). Parental support is imperative in supporting the high expectations Astrea Academy Sheffield has. If parents are unsure if uniform meets Astrea's policy, please contact the academy prior to purchasing any item(s) or committing to any appointments, for example, for false nails or piercings which are not allowed.

Uniform

Uniform should be worn correctly and if scholar's uniform does not meet the required expectation, negative points will be awarded to scholars in line with the behaviour policy. If a scholar arrives at the academy without the correct uniform, they will be given the correct uniform to wear. If a scholar refuses to wear the borrowed uniform, then the scholar will stay in the Reset Space (RS) until a parent or carer can bring in the correct uniform or remain in RS until the end of the academy day.

NOTES

All <u>religious headwear</u> should be **BLACK** and contain no embellishments.

<u>Belts</u> should be black or navy blue and made from leather/leather look material with a plain buckle.

<u>Leggings</u> underneath skirts are not permitted.

PE kit

When scholars have PE or a sport elective, they are allowed to wear the PE kit for the school day. However, if scholars arrive to the academy in their PE kit when they do not have PE or a sport elective scholars will receive -3 negative behaviour points.

Additional important information:

Long hair should be tied up, watches need to be removed.

Appropriate religious headwear can be worn but should be secured correctly.

When scholars have PE (practical) or a sport elective, scholars can attend the academy in their PE kit.

If scholars do not have their PE kit they will receive a negative (-2) behaviour point. Scholars should have a note from a parent if they are unable to take part in PE. Involvement within the lesson will still be required from scholars but this may be in a coach/assistant role.

Accessories and other non-uniform

Scholars are not permitted to wear jewellery of any type. A plain wristwatch may be worn but this is not to be a smartwatch of any kind, all other items are not permitted. Below is a list to inform parents of additional uniform expectations, this list is not exhaustive.

- Hair bobbles should be black
- * Badges, other than school issued badges, should not be worn on any uniform.
- No depiction of national flags or religious/political groups to be worn/displayed.
- Make up should not be visible, fake tan should look natural
- * Eyelash extension/fake eyelashes are not permitted
- * False or painted nails are not permitted
- ★ No caps or hats unless religious headwear
- Balaclavas and bandanas are both banned items.
- * Facial piercings are not permitted. This includes translucent piercings.
- No plasters to cover piercings
- Contact lenses should be clear and intended to correct vision only novelty contact lenses are not permitted (they should not be unnaturally coloured or patterned).

Scholars will remain in the Reset Space until the uniform breach is rectified.

Equipment required to access lessons

In senior school all scholars have been issued with the following equipment to prepare them in advance of the academic year ahead.

- Reading book
- ★ Morning Meeting Booklet
- ★ 1 x pencil case with the following contents:
- ★ 2 x black or blue writing pens
- ¥ 1 x red pen
- ¥ 1 x pencil
- ★ 1 x pencil sharpener
- ★ 1 x highlighter
- * A ruler
- * A rubber
- ★ A Calculator (Y10 and Y11 scholars only 1 calculator will be provided by the academy)
- ★ A bag (Astrea Academy Sheffield bag in Y7)

The above equipment should be carried in an Astrea Academy Sheffield branded bag

Equipment will be checked daily in Tutor/Morning Meeting. Failure to bring this equipment will result in a negative point (-1) issued by the scholar's tutor (so negatives are not repeatedly issued). Scholars will then be given equipment from their tutor (which they are to return) so they are prepared for the day.

If any equipment is lost or damaged, it is the responsibility of scholars, parents/carers to replace this equipment.

The Principal will make all final decisions on uniform, whether it is deemed acceptable and in line with the expectations we have of all our scholars.
