## Y8 HPV Vaccinations

The School Age Immunisation Team will be visiting schools from January 2026 to deliver the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine. The HPV vaccine reduces your risk of getting HPV, a common virus that's spread through skin contact. Some types of HPV are linked to an increased risk of certain types of cancer. Both boys and girls are eligible for this vaccine. Research suggests that over time the HPV vaccine will help save thousands of lives in the UK.

They need your consent to give your child the vaccine. When filling in the consent form, you will have 2 options:

- Yes – To give consent to your child receiving the HPV vaccine.
- No - To not give consent

Don't forget you will need to let us know on the Wednesday of the week before whether you want your child to eat the school food or a packed lunch for the following week.

You must let us know if you want to change whether you are opted in or out.

If you are opted in and want to stay in, you don't need to do anything - same for if you are opted out and want to stay out. However, if you want to change from opted in to opted out or vice versa, you must let us know by the Wednesday before the week you want to change.

If you do not let us know that you would like to opt out of family dining, then you will still be charged.

Please also remind your child that if they are bringing in a packed lunch from home then they must not have a school dinner. Unfortunately, we are seeing scholars who have chosen to opt out of family dining but are still eating the school lunch which means they will still be charged.
