Attendance</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attend the academy every day</li> <li>Arrive well before the academy gates close at 8:17am</li> <li>Be punctual to all lessons, morning meetings and Astrea Reads</li> </ul>	<p><b>1. Attendance</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ensure my child is attending the academy every day</li> <li>Share important information with key staff that may impact my child's attendance</li> <li>Work with the Academy to overcome any barrier to attending</li> <li>Report any absence directly to the academy attendance team before 8:15am on each day of absence via phone or MCAS</li> <li>Ensure my child gets a minimum of 8 hours of sleep a night</li> <li>Removing electronic devices for at least 1 hour before bedtime</li> <li>Have a consistent morning routine which ensures my child arrives safely at the academy well before 8:15am</li> <li>Make all appointments (medical or other) outside of the academy day so my child's attendance is not impacted</li> </ul>	<p><b>1. Attendance</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Phone home when a scholar is absent and we have not been contacted by the parent/carer/guardian</li> <li>Record any lateness to the academy or lessons via ClassCharts</li> <li>Motivate scholars to attend by planning and delivering excellent lessons</li> <li>Motivate scholars to attend through a range of attendance rewards</li> </ul>
<p><b>2. In Lessons</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Follow staff instructions - first time, every time</li> <li>Arrive on time, fully equipped and ready to learn</li> <li>Enter the classroom in silence, following academy routines</li> <li>Be polite and show respect to others</li> <li>Work hard with maximum effort</li> <li>Demonstrate pride in the presentation of my work, completing everything to the best of my ability</li> <li>Be prepared to answer questions using "match my volume"</li> <li>Ask for, accept and make use of support when I need it</li> <li>Contribute positively to disruption free learning</li> <li>Be brave and prepared to get things wrong. We learn best from our mistakes</li> <li>Complete homework on time, every time, to the best of my ability, and see staff before the deadline if I need help</li> </ul>	<p><b>2. In Lessons</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Maintain a consistent evening routine so my child is equipped and prepared for learning the next day</li> <li>Actively support my child to complete all schoolwork and homework to the best of their ability.</li> <li>Ensure my child logs onto Carousel, SPARX and any other platforms required to complete all homework on time</li> <li>Support the academy in upholding the behaviour policy to ensure for disruption free classrooms</li> <li>Contact the academy at the earliest opportunity should I have any concerns regarding progress, attainment or behaviour</li> <li>Check my child's ClassCharts daily to celebrate successes and discuss incorrect choices</li> </ul>	<p><b>2. In Lessons</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Maintain high expectations of all scholars and communicate this live through ClassCharts to celebrate successes and issue sanction for poor behaviour</li> <li>Keep you up to date about your child's progress through academic reports, scholar review evenings and contact you at the earliest opportunity if we are concerned about your child's welfare, learning or behaviour</li> <li>Provide opportunities and spaces at the end of the academy day, such as the library and computer rooms, for scholars to complete homework</li> </ul>

<p><b>3. Around the academy</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Arrive to the academy wearing full school uniform (or PE kit on days where I have PE) for the whole the school day</li> <li>• Take responsibility for ensuring the academy site remains clean and tidy</li> <li>• Follow all staff instructions – first time, every time</li> <li>• Demonstrate positive social behaviours to avoid inappropriate or unwanted physical contact</li> <li>• Keep corridors safe by moving around the building with pace and purpose (on the left, in single file and in silence)</li> <li>• Adhere to our no-phone policy</li> <li>• Keep myself and other scholars safe</li> </ul>	<p><b>3. Around the academy</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure my child arrives wearing full school uniform for the entire school day.</li> <li>• Use ClassCharts and communicate with staff to support the academy behaviour policy</li> <li>• Lead by example to demonstrate positive social behaviours for my child (in person and online)</li> <li>• Support the academy no phone policy</li> </ul>	<p><b>3. Around the academy</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lead by example by wearing professional dress as outlined in our staff handbook</li> <li>• Give explicit instructions so scholars are clear on expectations</li> <li>• Implement the behaviour policy with warmth and consistency</li> <li>• Be present around the academy to ensure learning spaces, corridors and social areas are safe</li> <li>• Engage with scholars about their interests to build positive relationships and foster a sense of belonging for all</li> <li>• Listen to and respond to scholars worries and concerns</li> <li>• Support the academy no phone policy by providing safe storage</li> </ul>
<p><b>4. Representing the Academy in the wider community</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Act as a responsible citizen, showing respect and support for others in our community</li> <li>• Act as an ambassador for the academy, and embody our values at all times</li> <li>• Share letters and communication from the academy with home promptly</li> </ul>	<p><b>4. Representing the Academy in the wider community</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Work positively with the Academy by attending all review evenings and scheduled meetings on time</li> <li>• Act promptly on letters or information sent home</li> </ul>	<p><b>4.
