This week has seen the vast majority of exams finish for Years 11 and 13 – well done to everyone for their extraordinary effort in this final push! Only a small number of exams remain, and students only have to attend school for these exams moving forward and can sign out straight after.

Sixth form refurb update

Our site walk on Thursday focussed on making our final selections for the floors, walls and blinds and seeing samples for the ceiling (the wood slats with black acoustic material between shown below). It was also nice to start showing some of our current year 12 students around the site and getting their feedback on the initial design choices.

So, the final choices are:

• White paint in eggshell on most of the walls, but the stage area will still retain the black walls of the design.

- Carpet in the meeting room is Bellatrix 90 (which is a brown/ grey and should match with the steel grey of furniture backs)
- Flooring in the toilets is Dove Grey 7767 (to tie in with Vinyl in all but meeting room and toilets is Sweet Honey Oak (the best match for the ceiling slats)
- The roll blinds will be anthracite.





School day adjustment during mocks/ assessments

From Monday 16 June 2025 the remaining year 7, 8 and 9 assessments start, followed by the main year 10 mocks the week after. These assessment take between 45 and 65 minutes to complete, and some students will need additional time for their access arrangements. In order to give students the time they need, and to ensure that we don't impact on too many other lessons we are adjusting the times of the school day as follows:

- 0830 0845: AM Tutorial (including morning welcome)
- 0845 0950: Period 1 (now 65 minutes long)
- 0950 1045: Period 2 (still 55 minutes long)

- 1045 1105: Break (unchanged)
- 1105 1200: Period 3 (unchanged)
- 1200 1245: Lunch for everyone
- 1245 1300: PM Tutorial
- 1300 1405: Period 4 (now 65 minutes long)
- 1405 1500: Period 5 (still 55 minutes long)

You will notice that periods 1 and 4 have been extended to fit these assessments into one teacher period, meaning that there should be little disruption to periods 2 and 5 for years 7, 8 and 9.

Over the coming months, local post-16 providers, including sixth forms and colleges will be holding open events.
