#### Dear Parent / Carer / Year 11 Scholar

We are writing to you to provide a year 11 update and inform you about the upcoming revision sessions and mock exams.

Firstly, I want to congratulate scholars on their excellent attitude and efforts this half term - they have made a superb start! Please continue to have conversations with your child about the importance of attendance in year 11. All post-16 providers have an expectation that attendance is above 95%. As we approach half term 95% attendance means nearly 10 lessons missed, and by the end of year 11 95% attendance will mean 45 lessons have been missed!
