PROM

Every child currently has a free ticket. We have never done this before and are excited to be able to fund this significant reward at the end of year 11.

The ticket remains free if your child has attendance above 97% and your child receives less than 20 demerits between January and the prom.

Your child is still warmly invited to prom but must purchase a ticket if their attendance is between 90% and 97%, or they receive more than 20 demerits, between January and the prom.

Your child will not be able to attend prom if their attendance drops below 90% (without an approved reason), or they have significant behaviour issues between now and the prom.

The most common demerits in year 11 are late to the academy and late to line ups. Please remind your child that being punctual is important! It is extremely rare in year 11 for a child to have more than 20 demerits.

All decisions regarding prom attendance are at the discretion of Mr Scales.

College and Careers Appointments:

All year 11 scholars should have applied for at least two post-16 places by now. Your child might also wish to apply for an apprenticeship, which tend to be advertised between April and June. If your child intends to apply for an apprenticeship, they still need to have applied for a college/sixth form place as a backup. Please check deadlines with individual colleges and sixth forms, they are fast approaching. We are happy to support with these applications.

All year 11 scholars will have a careers appointment with our independent careers advisor, Lindsey Rugby-Andrew. Scholars are able to request an additional appointment by speaking to Mr Simon Harper. Lindsey will then schedule an appointment for a scholar the following week. Parents are able to request support or guidance from Lindsey by emailing Lindsey. Please be aware that Lindsey only works on a Thursday and will reply during working hours on a Thursday.
