- 99.21% Strongly agreed/agreed that your child enjoys school.
- 100% Strongly agree/agree that your child feels safe at school.
- 99,21% Strongly agree/agree that your child is given help & support by the teacher.
- 99.21% Strongly agree/agree that Mill Hill Primary is a welcoming school.
- 96.03% Strongly agree/agree that school has high expectations of your child.
- 100% Strongly agree/agree that you can talk to your child's teacher if and when you need to.
- 99.21% Strongly agree/agree that the school has high expectations regarding behaviour.
- 97.26% Strongly agree/agree that children are equally valued at school.
- 96.3% Strongly agree/agree that your child brings homework home regularly.
- 96.83% Strongly agree/agree that school actively encourages healthy eating & living.
- 98.41% Strongly agree/agree that you are informed of your child's progress.
- 99.21% Strongly agree/agree that teaching is good at Mill Hill Primary School.
- 90.48% Strongly agree/agree that your child is well prepared for the future.
- 95.24% Strongly agree/agree that this school is led and managed effectively.
