# St Mary's College key reminders for Year 6 parents/carers in preparation for September 2020:



## Attendance:

- Students must be punctual to school and all lessons to ensure attendance is accurate students must be in school on time for morning registration: 8:45am.
- St Mary's College minimum expectation regarding attendance is 97%.
- If your child is unable to attend school please contact school before 9am please ring school each day your child is absent.
- Wherever possible, please book medical appointments out of school time or during school holidays. If this is not possible, appointments made after 2pm have the least impact on your child's attendance.
- St Mary's College does not authorise any holidays taken during term time.
- Please refer to the attendance section of the enclosed 'Keeping Children Safe in Education' leaflet.

# Getting to and from school:

- Please ensure your child knows how they are getting to and from school every day especially if the arrangements will vary on different days of the week.
- If your child will be getting a school bus please ensure your child knows the number bus they must use and where to get on and off the bus. Further information will be sent home regarding arrangements for school buses in July.
- If you will be dropping your child off and/or collecting them from school please try to do this beyond the school gates rather than driving into the school car parks - we aim to minimise congestion and movement of traffic on the school site at busy times to ensure the safety of students arriving and leaving school and your support with this is greatly appreciated.
- Parents/carers can drop students off at the bus loop in the morning but this is NOT possible at the end of school due to the arrival of the buses.
- There is a bike store on the school site to ensure these belongings are safe throughout the day students may not ride bikes on the school site.

#### **Belongings:**

- Students are responsible for all of their own belongings in Year 7.
- Please ensure <u>everything</u> is clearly named with your child's FULL name.
- We don't have lockers / cloakrooms students must carry all of their belongings with them at all times.
- Students should not bring expensive items to school.
- Students must have all compulsory items of equipment with them each day (see enclosed equipment checklist)
- Students must have a strong school bag / rucksack to carry all of their things in each day.

# Mobile Phones & Internet safety:

- Mobile phones can NOT be used at all during school time and must be switched off in bags all day

   they are students' own responsibility.
- Will be confiscated if used and must then be collected from Main Reception at the end of the day.
- Under no circumstances can phones be used to take photos or videos of other students or staff this is a very serious offence.
- Any problems: come to the Year 7 office and make phonecall from there using school phone.
- If a student uses their mobile phone during the school day (including breaktime and lunchtime) it will be confiscated and taken to the Main Reception from where it can be collected at the end of the day.

- If a student's mobile phone is confiscated three times, his/her parent/carer must come into school to collect it.
- Students must only use sites on the internet that are accessible via the school network during school time.
- Please monitor your child's use of social media outside of school to ensure issues do not arise in school.
- Please refer to the online safety section of the enclosed 'Keeping Children Safe in Education' leaflet.

#### Personal Appearance:

- Uniform must be correct for September plain black shoes NO trainers NO boots, school coats only.
- No make-up, nail varnish or jewellery including earrings. A watch can be worn but 'smart' watches are not permitted.
- No extreme hairstyles.
- Please refer to guidance in uniform booklet enclosed and please see most recent uniform letter sent home as guidance for current SMC students.

## Lunchtime options:

- Packed lunch can eat outside or in Social Area.
- Cold / Hot dinner in canteen.
- School dinner costs approx. £2.30 students can spend more please ensure sufficient money is on their Parentpay account.
- If your child receives a free school meal at Primary school they will receive a free school meal at St Mary's College.
- Students can also purchase snacks and drinks from the canteen at breaktime.

#### Toilets:

- Y6 students are encouraged to use the toilets in the morning, at breaktime and at lunchtime in Year 7.
- Students will be allowed to leave lessons to go to the toilet but this should reduce as the first half term progresses.
- Y6/7 students can drink water in lessons students require their own water bottle.

# Homework:

- Homework will be set from all subjects from start of Year 7 as per the Key Stage 3 policy.
- In Y7 students should expect to have approximately 2 hours of homework per week.
- Parents / carers should check planner each day to support with this.
- Homework club will take place each lunchtime in Y7 area to support with completion of homework.

- If you need to come into school for a meeting or to collect your child please report to the Main Reception.
- Parents/carers are not permitted to enter the school site without reporting to the Main Reception.
