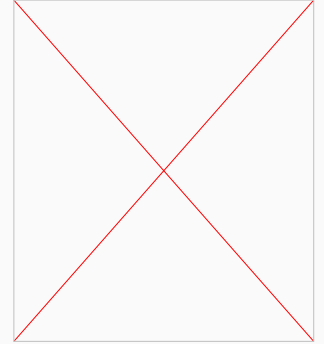
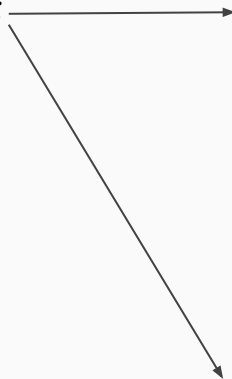
Student services

Reception Office



- The office team are really helpful.
- There are 2 hatches for you to use
- The office staff will be able to help you with first aid, lost timetables or ringing home etc.
- There is always someone available to help from 8.00am to 4.00pm

Contact with parents/carers



- Hopefully you will be organised and never forget anything, but in the event that you do, please ask the office to phone a parent for you.
- If your parent/carer is kind enough to bring it in to school for you, it is your responsibility to collect it from the office.
- If your parent/carer needs to get a message to you before the end of the school day, for example changing lifts, then they must inform the office before 2:30pm to give enough time for that message to be delivered.
- REMEMBER – for any issues

do not contact your parents.

Lockers



- Your parents are being given the opportunity to hire a locker for you to use, so you don't have to carry heavy bags.
- You will be given your locker key in the first week of the new term
- We would recommend that you place this key on your lanyard to keep it safe.
- If you would like to change lockers, please see one of the office team. Do not swap lockers between yourselves.
- You will only be able to access your lockers at breaks and the start and end of lunchtimes



School Ties



Every student should be wearing a tie, all day, every day.
Please make sure you put your name on your tie

If you forget your tie

- Please come to Reception and we will lend you one for the day. You will need to leave us something of value, and this item will be returned to you at the end of the day when the tie is handed in.
- You will be given a tie to wear with a red stripe on - This shows it has been borrowed and you need to return it.

If you forget your tie regularly, you will be asked to attend a break-time detention

If you lose your tie

- You can buy a new one from Reception for £5



First Aid



- If you feel unwell or become injured during any point in the day, then tell a member of staff who will send or take you to the office
- The office staff will provide support or call for a first aider to help you. They will also contact home for you if needed
YOU SHOULD NOT CONTACT PARENTS YOURSELF.
- The First Aid room is situated near the office
- If you require any medication during school time, you must leave it at the office. It will be kept safe and given to you at the specified time and recorded.

School Transport



If your parent/carer arranges for you to have a place on one of our school buses, please remember:

- You must have a pass to travel on the bus, which will only be issued once your parents have paid. You will need to show this pass to the driver as you get on the bus
- You must behave and listen to instructions from the driver.
- You should always be polite to the driver
- You should remain seated whilst the bus is moving.



Any poor behaviour could lead to you being banned from using the bus!
