Dear Parent / Carer

Following on from our previous correspondence you will be aware that all schools received guidance from the government around the reopening of schools in September:

In the final weeks of term we spent considerable time planning how we would best implement this guidance to meet the needs of our community. I feel it is important to note that every setting is different and will consequently come up with a different solution to the challenges posed by reopening. Having worked closely with the LA, Local Heads and Unions it is apparent there is not a one size fits all approach. Our plans reflect our unique context and the constraints of our campus.

Our guiding principles have been to:

- Keep our whole community as safe as possible through robust safety measures
- Deliver the curriculum in its entirety, keeping the breadth and depth of what we had planned
- Ensuring students are as well prepared as they can be for any future examinations across their full complement of subjects
- Re-establishing the normal running of the campus as far as possible.

As you can imagine there has been a lot to consider and we have tried to plan for all eventualities as far as possible. The guidance booklet here will hopefully give a comprehensive overview of our intentions moving forward.

In summary our plans can be defined as follows:

- All students to follow a normal timetable of lessons in all subjects
- Students to operate in distinct year group bubbles
- Bubbles to be kept apart and contacts between groups minimised by a robust movement plan
- The majority of movement / student circulation to be outside and not in corridors
- Strong hygiene procedures to be followed at all times and social distancing to be observed wherever possible. The wearing of masks is strongly encouraged within school and whilst using service buses. Masks must be worn when using public transport.

To ensure that our plans can be implemented effectively, and students can be informed of all that they need to know to be on site safely, we are planning a phased reopening as outlined below.

Only the year groups designated will be in school each day so that we can run through our safety procedures and build capacity slowly towards a full opening on Tuesday 1st September. Work will be set in Google Classrooms for students to complete on the days they are not in school.

We will continue to take account of the guidance as and when it's released and update our plans accordingly. I hope that the information above and that contained within the booklet goes some way to answering any questions you may have.
