Good morning,

Following on from our letter yesterday I am sure you are aware that the Government announced that all A level and GCSE students would now receive their Centre Assessed Grades to ensure all students get the grades they deserve this summer. We are now in the process of responding to the guidance so far to ensure we have everything in place for Year 11 on Thursday this week, Thursday will continue to take place as outlined in our previous letter this week. We still await further guidance in some areas but what we do know from what has been released in the statement above is:

- Students will be informed of Centre Assessed Grades on Thursday by their school
- Students will receive their official results next week
- BTEC qualifications are not currently affected by the announcement
- If students calculated grade was due to be higher than their Centre Assessed Grade they will receive the higher of the two grades

We are pleased by the decision that has been made by the Government and our commitment at BGLC remains to do everything we can to support our students to get onto a suitable pathway for them to continue their educational journey and to ensure they are all treated fairly. On Thursday we will support our students as much as possible to confirm their next steps whether that be in BGLC Post 16 or at another Post 16 provider, staff will be on site on Thursday to offer support and guidance to you all.

At this stage please could we also make it clear that the grades being supplied are centre assessed grades that have been through a rigorous process, as such any queries should be directed to the exams office (exams@brookvalegroby.com) and not the individual teacher.
