## YEAR 2 PERSONAL INVESTIGATION

#### **SELF DIRECTED Component (60%)**

- Worth 60% of the overall grade.
- You decide the theme of your personal investigation.
- Can include: A Theme / Concept / Issue / Ideas / Genre
- Must be an in-depth study in which candidates are expected to consolidate the skills, knowledge and understanding developed in Year 1.
- Demonstrate an awareness of all four assessment objectives.













#### INDEPENDENT THEMES





#### External Component (40%)

- Worth 40% of the overall grade.
- You choose 1 of a number of starting points for a practical project.
- The starting points change every year and are varied in content.
- Again, an in-depth study in which candidates are expected to consolidate the skills, knowledge and understanding developed in Year 1 & 2 experience gained by working on the Personal Investigation
- Must demonstrate an awareness of all four assessment objectives.

#### 2 YEARS WHAT WILL STUDENTS GAIN?

- Knowledge on how to present their work professionally in groups and independently.
- Know how to annotate their work thoroughly and use artist influences to develop their work.
- Have access to exemplary projects from earlier peers.
- Gain new skills, knowledge & understanding of varied genres within Photography and Art and Design.
- Use peer & self-assessment to further learning.
- Have opportunities to visit external shows / Exhibitions & present their own work locally.
- Gain relevant knowledge of the arts industry.
- Gain support and guidance when applying for Art & Design further education courses.
