Dear Parents/Carers

We have been made aware this afternoon of a positive case of COVID-19 within our Year 7 cohort.

We know that you may find this concerning but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with Public Health England. This letter is to inform you of the current situation and all advice and how to support your child is available on our website. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

Parents/Carers of those students who have been in close contact with the individuals who have tested positive have received a letter today informing them that their child must stay at home for 14 days from contact date.

Clearly with the deteriorating situation nationally it highlights the need for us all to ensure we adhere to all the guidance that has been shared and most importantly that students are not sent to school when they may have symptoms or have been in contact with those that have tested positive.

We continue to work closely with the official bodies to ensure our community stays safe and we are able to continue a high quality education to our students.
