MyOn Reading Programme

All students in Y7 to Y11 will be given online access next week to over 2,000 books through the MyOn program from Renaissance.

The students will be given a username and password by their English teacher and will then be able to access the MyOn collection. The books in the collection cover a wide range of reading ages and include both fiction and non fiction titles. The program allows students to monitor the number of books they have read and even keep a record of the minutes they have spent reading. Teachers will be able to check this information too and ensure that students are reading regularly.

The programme includes a range of features designed to support reading, such as an in-built dictionary and the chance to listen to audio versions of many of the books. Students are able to add sticky notes and post questions for teachers to address. This is particularly useful for some of the set texts in English, which are available through MyOn.

We would ask that you encourage your son/daughter to use MyOn as a supplement to the reading they do with physical books. This will help fulfil their 20 minutes reading a day, part of the 20/20/20 homework, and help them develop the strong reading skills they need for success at GCSE.
