Dear Student,

As the weather gets warmer it's a good time to remind everyone about the post 16 dress code.

The dress code can be found on the last page of the <u>student handbook</u> on our website and is attached for information.

If you breach the dress code you will be challenged. If you have a coat or jacket that you can wear that will cover it up you will be expected to wear this at all times during that day, indoors and outdoors, which may be pretty uncomfortable. We have a limited supply of clothing which we will lend to students who breach the dress code, or you will be asked to go home to change. You will be asked to leave something as a deposit e.g. a phone case or headphones, which will be returned to you when you return the clean item of clothing. Returned clothing will be placed in quarantine for 72 hours before being loaned again.

We expect students to be appropriately dressed for a learning environment and for our 11 to 18 age ranged school and feel our dress code clearly outlines what is acceptable in Post 16. If you are unsure about anything then please ask a member of staff. All members of our community have a dress code to adhere to, including staff, so please ensure you are following the rules of Post 16 at all times.

	Tights and leggings can only be worn under a skirt or dress of mid-thigh length or longer. Skirt and dress length needs to be mid-thigh or longer.	
	In the Summer term only, shorts are acceptable as long as they are tailored and mid-thigh length or longer.	V T
