FOR PARENTS/CARERS OF CLOSE CONTACTS OF LATERAL FLOW CASE IN YEAR 11

Advice for Student

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the home lateral flow testing currently taking place a student within our Year 11 cohort has returned a positive result.

In line with government guidance all positive results from rapid tests undergone at home do need to be confirmed with a standard PCR Test. Whilst awaiting the PCR result, the student and their close contacts should self-isolate.

Your son/daughter has been identified as a social contact having been in close contact with the affected person.

If the PCR test is negative, it overrides the self-test LFD test and students can return to school. We will advise you as soon as we have the confirmed result and whether your child can return to school or if they must self-isolate for the full 10 day period.

Other members of your household can continue normal activities provided your child does not develop symptoms.
