FOR PARENTS/CARERS OF YEAR 7 CLOSE CONTACTS OF LATERAL FLOW CASE

Advice for Student

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of the home lateral flow testing currently taking place, a member of our community has returned a positive result.

In line with government guidance all positive results from rapid tests undergone at home do need to be confirmed with a standard PCR Test. Whilst awaiting the PCR result, all close contacts should self-isolate. We will advise of the result as soon as possible so please continue to check your emails.

We have checked social contacts, timetables and seating plans and have identified that your son/daughter has been in close contact with the affected person.

If the PCR test is negative, it overrides the self-test LFD test and students can return to school. We will advise you as soon as we have the confirmed result and whether your child can return to school or if they must self-isolate for the full 10 day period.

Other members of your household can continue normal activities provided your child does not develop symptoms.

We are also sending your child home with further home testing kits should the need arise to isolate for the full 10 days. Testing should continue to be undertaken during this period.
