We hope this assists in supporting your child and ensuring you are aware of the most important updates across the school.

All Years	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Latest newsletter - BGLC CAMPUS NEWSLETTER - JANUARY 2022● Please find a detailed overview of how your child is given feedback and supported to make progress - Feedback Overview.● Following the recent announcement from the Government, face coverings are now no longer required to be worn in lessons from Thursday 20th January.● Students are still expected to wear face coverings in communal areas and public transport until Thursday 27th January at which point they will no longer.● Please could we ensure all students are adhering to the published uniform policy - HERE. Checks will continue to be made on a daily basis.● From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6. <p>The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace - Report a Covid 19 Test Result</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Years 7-11 The Immunisations team will be on campus next week, Tuesday 25th, Wednesday 26th and Thursday 27th Jan for COVID and FLU vaccine sessions. <p>If you have not already consented, but wish for your child to have these, please fill in the consent form before Monday 24th.
