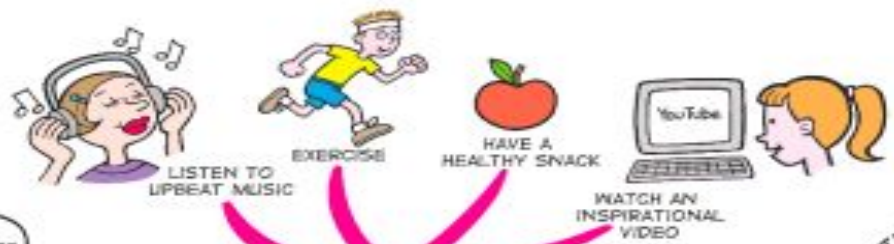

Organisation
