Dear Year 12s, Parents/Carers,


Year 12 Spring Lakes trip - Tuesday 5th July

As an end of year celebration, we would like to take the Year 12 students to **Spring Lakes Watersports and Leisure** on **Tuesday 5th July.** The students have demonstrated resilience throughout the last 2 years, and we felt that it was the perfect time to have a little bit of fun outside of the classroom. Our Year 12 students will have completed their mocks and it will be the final week of term.

Not only does Spring Lakes offer a huge amount of fun which doubles up as exercise out in the fresh air, it promotes health and wellbeing with open water activities being proven to prevent and manage many different health conditions, including anxiety, depression and other mental health issues, which I am sure you will agree are probably at an all-time high after Covid and the lockdown situations we have had.

The cost of the trip is £38.00* which includes:

- Travel to and from the venue
- Lunch
- All equipment needed, including use of a wetsuit
- Aqua Park inflatables experience
- Learning to wakeboard and kneeboard
- Learning to stand up paddleboard
- Banana boat rides on the 2.0 intermediate cable
- · Exploring the lakes on a pedalo and
- Chilling out on the beach.



The **deadline for payment** via Weduc is **22nd May 2022**. The Trip is listed as an offer, under your payments purse. Students in receipt of the bursary may have the cost of the trip subsidised.

*Please note this charge is dependent on sufficient numbers wishing to go on the trip to cover the bus cost. If numbers are low we may have to cancel the trip or charge more to each student.

Please also note these trip details:

- The trip is for a full day, leaving campus at 9am immediately after registration, returning to campus at 4pm.
- Students will need to make their own way home as we will return to campus after the school buses have left.
- Students should bring their swimsuit, towel and slip on shoes along with them, as well as sunscreen and a hat if we are fortunate with the warm weather.
- Health and Safety the water is spring fed so is incredibly clean, rather than being fed from the river. They
 also hold a licence from the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority (AALA) which is part of the HSE. There
