Any requests to leave campus will not be authorised, even if the request comes from a parent/carers. This arrangement is in place up to and including Friday 17 June. From Monday 20 June, students only need to attend if they have an exam or warm-up session.During form time over recent weeks, the focus has been on ensuring students are preparing effectively for the summer exam period, which is now well underway. We have been drawing inspiration from the PIXL Prepare to Perform initiative as
