Dear Parents/Carers of Year 10 Students,

Work Experience Opportunities:

In person: 17th July 2023 - 21st July 2023 **or** 24th July 2023 to 28th July 2023

Virtual Online: Portal available through the summer

We are working in partnership with the Leicestershire Education Business Company (LEBC) to offer students the opportunity to apply for a work experience placement during the summer break in 2023. LEBC have been organising work placements for students across Leicestershire for more than 20 years. Their website is www.leics-ebc.org.uk, if you would like to find out more about the organisation.

Placement Types

➤ **Physical Placement Organised by LEBC**

The cost for your son/daughter to take part will be **£58 per placement**. For this price LEBC will:

- Set up the work experience placement trying to meet your son/daughter's preference including workplace assessment of health, safety and welfare arrangements.
- Send you a contract agreement which sets out the job description and generic young person's risk assessment which your son/daughter will take to interview.

➤ **Self-Placement**

Should a student wish to organise their own work placement LEBC will carry out all appropriate checks to ensure the placement is suitable and safe, on our behalf. This carries a **cost of £51** and requires completion of the application form as well as an additional self-placement form.

The **student must be available for work experience the week commencing either 17th July or 24th July 2023**. We are unable to refund or change dates.

➤ **Virtual Experience Organised by LEBC**

The cost for your son/daughter to take part will be **£17.50 per placement**. For this price LEBC will;

- Set up the student with an account on a secure website.
- Allow the student to have access to the materials for the whole of the summer holiday
- Each student can choose two sectors to explore
- An employer will feedback on the student's project

This work experience is set for the summer holidays, so the students will get the login details just before we break up. On average it takes eight hours to complete the work experience units, and a few more hours to complete their optional additional project. Students will receive a certificate from LEBC on completion of their work experience.

How students can take part

For those students who wish to take part in the **virtual** online work experience, they need to:

- **pick two choices** from the student directory
- **For the virtual work experience just fill out this form**

- **pay the appropriate fee** (Virtual £17.50). This will be assigned to your child's account within their **Arbor School Shop on completion of the google form. Payment deadline is Friday 11th November 2022.**

For in-person work experience:

- **complete and return the attached application** (also on website page) to the Reception office by Friday 28 October 2022.
- **pay the appropriate fee** (Full £58/ Self £51). This will be assigned to your child's account within their **Arbor School Shop on completion of the application form and submission of their completed application. Payment deadline is Friday 11th November 2022.**

Please note we are unable to refund work experience on the grounds of the student not being keen on the placement they have received, chosen themselves, clashes with holidays they have booked or non-attendance.
