In the ADT department at Brookvale Groby Learning Campus we aim to give our students the opportunity to access a wide ranging curriculum. Parental contributions are essential in helping to cover the costs of materials and equipment in ADT lessons. We therefore ask that all students taking an ADT option subject make a voluntary contribution of **£17.50** per subject to cover the costs for the 2 years on the course. This makes it possible for our students to develop skills in using special materials and equipment. In the past we requested £20 per ADT subject.
