- All students in Year 11 have recently completed their first test paper of the year in Maths and been provided with the Question Level Analysis (QLA) of their results. All students are required to complete 5 quizzes on Hegarty Maths related to questions they didn't fully understand on the paper (highlighted in Red or Yellow). This personalised approach to homework is proven to help students focus on their own individual needs and do better next time they see these topics. Any students who haven't received their QLA should ask their teacher who will then be able to provide them with it.

This will become common practice when our students start past paper practice after Christmas, with a two week cycle involving a paper one week and 5 Hegarty tasks the second week. Mr Kilduff
