Remembrance Day - Friday 11th November.

In addition to the assemblies next week which will focus on Remembrance, we will also be holding our own Act of Remembrance around our flag pole. As part of this, we plant wooden crosses with the names of all of the men whose names are listed on the Groby and Ratby War Memorials around our own campus flag pole.

Students who are a member of a uniformed organisation (Scouts, Guides, Armed or Emergency Service Cadets, St. Johns Ambulance etc) are invited to wear their uniform to school that day and to take part in this ceremony. Also, if student's have a family member whose name is on either of these war memorials, and would like to plant the cross with their name on it, these students would be welcome to do so.

Students wishing to do either of these things should notify their Form Tutor, who will contact Mr Godwin, as he is collating the list of those who would like to participate.

Remembrance Day Poppy Appeal - students will have the opportunity to make a donation in exchange for paper poppies, coloured wrist bands or reflective zip poppies. The poppy items will be brought round during form time this coming week, so students wishing to buy a poppy should bring in their cash donation from Monday.
