How to Succeed in Year 10 Religious Studies

- a commitment to independent study (homework and revision)

In Religious Studies we provide the following support to ensure that all students make the best possible progress:

Knowledge organisers - These can be used to revise the key learning ideas. Students have copies of these in their homework booklet. Digital copies are also available here: - <u>Year 10</u> & <u>Year 11</u>

PLCs - These can be used to assess the knowledge for each topic in Religious Studies. Students will be using these to RAG the understanding for each topic, this is a useful technique when revising. All students have copies of these in their class books.

Google classroom - This is where students will find useful information regarding their GCSE Religious Studies subject. Students will be able to access past exam papers and markschemes from the AQA exam board. There will also be website links for students to access further revision material, topical articles relating to a specific unit they may be studying, and revision tips and guides to aid their learning.

Homework - We expect students to spend up to <u>40 minutes</u> completing their Religious Studies homework each week. Booklets are provided for each topic studied, that contain the schedule of homework for each week. Homework should be completed in the spaces provided, following the clear instructions contained for each task. This will be checked and completion recorded weekly, on an agreed day. Homework booklets are also available to print out from your child's Google Classroom for Religious Studies, should they lose or damage their original.

Extended Support - Additional support will be provided for specific students initially that would benefit the most from it. This will be an opportunity for them to ask any questions and

complete tasks with a smaller number of students. This support will then be opened up to all students as we approach the exams.
