Dear Student

As a prospective Post 16 student holding a conditional offer with us at Brookvale Groby Learning Campus to study your A Levels, we would like to invite you to our Induction Days on **Monday 3rd & Tuesday 4th July**. There will be a welcome assembly and taster sessions on Monday, and on Tuesday there is a chance to meet the Post 16 Team, staff and your tutor, as well as have some time for team building exercises with your tutor group and get to know the campus. You are encouraged to attend as many taster lessons as possible on Monday to get an introduction to the subjects you will be starting in September 2023. Post 16 staff will be on hand, as well as student ambassadors, to help you make the most of the event and answer any questions you may have.

You will need to find your own way to and from school on the induction days. If you are a current year 11 at BGLC you will be able to use your regular school bus if you have your bus pass. Timings are as follows;

Monday 8.40am - 3.10pm

Tuesday 8.45am - 11.30am.

Our canteen will be open for you to purchase food and drink; current BGLC students can still use their cashless catering cards and new students are able to purchase food and drink during the induction days using cash. Alternatively you can bring your own lunch with you.

Our Welcome Desk, in the Groby Building dining hall, will open from 8.15am and you will be greeted by some of our student ambassadors and asked to sign in and be given some details for the day. Our Welcome Assembly in the Brookvale Dining Room will begin at 8.45am and taster lessons run for the rest of the day. There will be plenty of Ambassadors (*Purple People!*) on hand to help you navigate the campus for the Induction and they will also be able to answer any questions you may have.

Our event will give you the opportunity to experience some lessons first hand, look around the campus, familiarise yourself with classrooms, teachers, and members of the Post 16 Team, prior to the start of the new academic year. All taster sessions are informative and will give you a strong insight into what to expect when you start in Post 16. If you are unsure about your subject choices or would like to try out other subjects before making your final decision on registry day then attending the taster sessions will help you. You will meet specialist subject teachers, find out more about the course content and any materials you may need for the course. The taster session timetable is attached and you can attend as many of the sessions as you wish on the day.
