

#### **All Years**

- Wear a Splash of Yellow for World Mental Health Day Tuesday 10th October (please note this is NOT a non-uniform day). <u>Click here</u> for more information on how to take part and to make a donation.
- Lost property we have an ever increasing number of lost property items at Reception. Please try to write names on labels or the inside of PE bags to help us reunite students with their lost property. Students can ask to view items at Reception during break or lunchtime.
- Pain Relief medication Students can carry 1 dose of pain relief on them during the school day. We do not hand any medication out in reception unless it is detailed in an IHCP (Individual Healthcare Plan). We often call home for Parents to bring in medication for headaches/Menstrual pain. By carrying some tablets, this will avoid students being out of their lessons and avoid parents coming onto campus to drop off.
- Student Illness/First Aids If a student calls Parents asking to come home, please contact reception before coming onto campus. Students are always encouraged back to class in the first instance for minor concerns. Sanctions will be issued for Students using phones on campus.

## Years 7, 8 and 9

**KS3 Homework Club** - has now resumed and takes place in the library, after school from 15:15 - 16:00 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Transport is not provided home for this so students will need to be collected or make their own way home.

Homework club is an opportunity for students to have additional support in a calm environment.

• In **Maths**, some of our Year 11s have sat their first exam paper of the year this week (except those students who did Stats last year).

This is in preparation of the mock exams coming up in November where students will sit two papers. Sparx Maths, this year's replacement for Hegarty Maths, offers independent learning for any student looking to improve constantly throughout the year, as well as weekly homework set to coincide with what is being taught in school.
