As always, the categories for this year celebrate the very best examples of effort and achievement. People can nominate for <u>Young Person of Courage</u>, <u>Young Volunteer</u>, <u>Young Leader</u>, and <u>Young Artist</u>.

The finalists and their parents or guardians will be invited to a special 'red carpet' awards evening and dinner, hosted by the Lord-Lieutenant, to be held next year. Each category winner will receive a prize to the value of <u>£500</u>!
