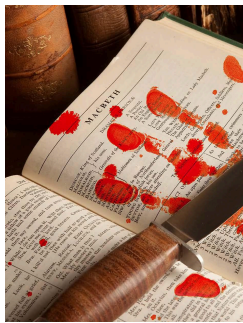
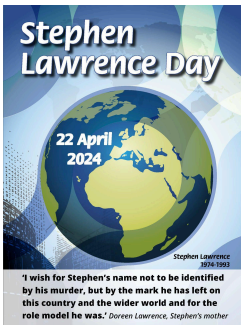

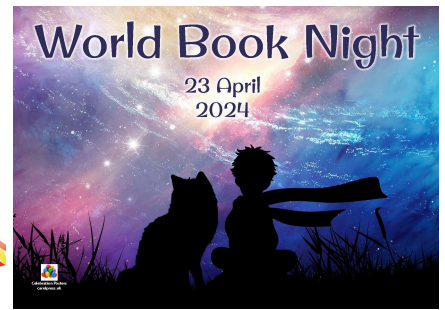
Good afternoon and welcome to this week's Parent Bulletin.
