As we move through the year, this page will fill with information about the books and about the ways in which families can get the most out of the amazing writing from a range of award-winning authors.




- Asking them about the book



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
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

	Face by Benjamin Zephania	Martin is a streetwise teenager not averse to misbehaving - but when a spot of joyriding goes wrong and he wakes up in hospital, his entire life is shattered. His face has had to be reconstructed, and with it, his sense of self and his relationships with those around him. As Martin struggles to regain his self-esteem and to overcome the prejudice of others, he discovers that life really is worth living and that appearance doesn't matter. A hard-hitting story that addresses the complex emotions surrounding disfigurement.	Autumn / Spring
