

 Please see message below from Mrs Bellamy - Faculty Leader - English, Media & Literacy:

It is routine practice for the class organisation in year 7 to be reviewed at the end of the first half term. We look at data that has come from the primary schools, alongside our Reading Plus data, and our growing knowledge of the students themselves.
