UK University & Apprenticeship Show - King Power Stadium - 11th March 2025 **UCAS Discovery East Midland Exhibition - NEC Birmingham - 24th June 2025**

We are delighted to announce we will be taking our Year 12 students to two events next year. Due to the importance of each event, we have booked coaches large enough for the entire cohort. We feel that these visits are an essential part of our Higher Education programme and are extremely valuable for Year 12 students considering their options at Post 18.

- Our first event is the **UK University & Apprenticeship Show** on 11th March 2025. This event will kick start the students' Post 18 research and give the students the opportunity to speak directly to Universities and Apprenticeship providers and collect prospectuses to assist them in making their Post 18 decisions later in the year.

We will be travelling by coach, departing from the campus at 9am and returning to school for lunchtime. All students are advised to take a drink and wear comfy shoes.

- The second event is the **UCAS Discovery Exhibition** at Birmingham's NEC on Thursday 24th June 2025. This is an excellent event which we have taken our students to annually and gives them a great opportunity to discover what is on offer for Post 18 and collect some information and talk to current students and representatives of universities they may be interested in.

There will be representatives from all UK & Ireland Universities present alongside Higher Degree Apprenticeship providers. This is a great way for our students to continue their Post 18 research. We will be travelling by coach, departing from the campus at 9am and returning at the end of the school day. We suggest students take a packed lunch and a drink. It is also handy if they take a bag to carry all of the prospectuses and information they have collected from the universities.

The total cost of transport to and from these two events is £22.00. To request a place, give you consent and to make the associated payment please look in Arbor/ Activities/ Trips. The **deadline to give consent and for payment is Friday 31st January 2025**.

Students in receipt of the bursary may have these trips funded and the cost will be appropriately adjusted for the individual students this applies to.
