

All Years	• We are fast approaching the exam season and self-care is so important for our students. This <u>website</u> has some great tips for students taking exams.

	• Creative Arts and technology options. We will be asking students to pick options for studying in year 9 for the Creative Arts and Technology subjects. This will allow students to study fewer subjects but in more depth, preparing them better for possible GCSE choices.
	The option process is starting again and all students must therefore respond to the new option choice form, which they will receive on Tuesday following their assembly to introduce this process. Students will be asked to rank the subject from 1 (the one they want to do the most) to 6 (the one they would least like to continue with).
	This process will now allow them to continue with 2 out of 6 subjects (from Art, Design, Drama, Food, Graphics and Textiles), this is different from the previous option process.
