Learning about money, counting pennies and adding pennies.

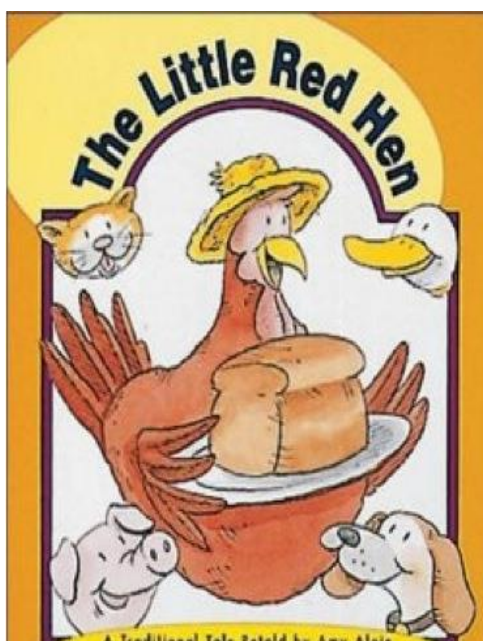
Things you can try at home.....
