King of The Cones


- Each player should have 3 cones, cups, tins etc. lined up in front of them



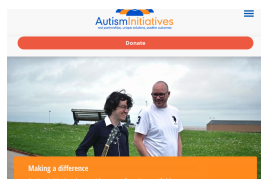

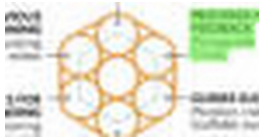
