## Statement on the use of 16:19 tuition fund

In the wake of the disruption to education caused by the COVID 19 pandemic, we will be providing additional in-school tuition. This will be for students in Year 12 who require further support in order to reach their full potential and attain at least a grade 4 in English and/or Maths. The tuition will be in the form of weekly small group sessions, of up to 5 students at a time and will take place after school, in addition to the students' regular study programme of education. The sessions will be tutored by existing teaching staff and will be quality assessed on a half-termly basis to ensure they remain effective and useful for our students.

Selection of students to attend the tutoring session will be made on the basis of need by the School's leadership. There is a very limited amount of funding being made available to Aylesbury High School, and there are strict limitations on how the funding can be used, so the sessions cannot be made available on request.

Where possible the additional tutoring will occur during lunchtimes to support students who travel to school by bus. It may be also possible to make use of some student self-study periods where part time staff are available to support this work outside their normal working day. Students selected for the tutoring will be expected to attend sessions in the same way as they would be for normal lessons.
