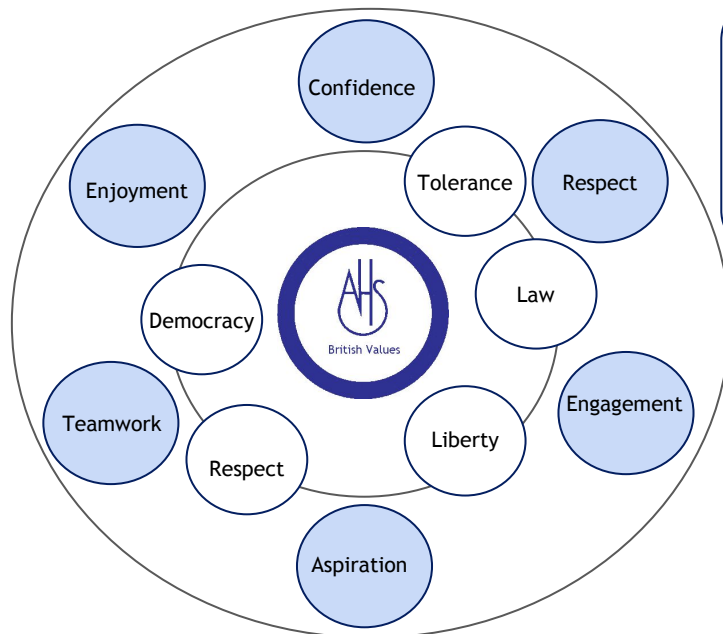
At Aylesbury High school we foster our school values to embed students understanding of the British Values.
