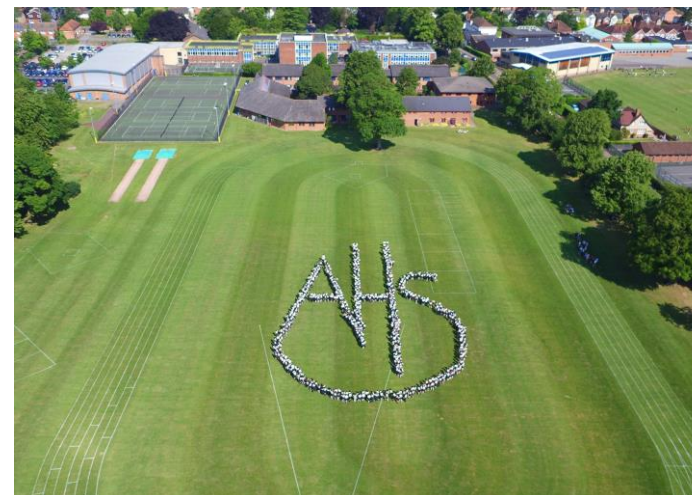

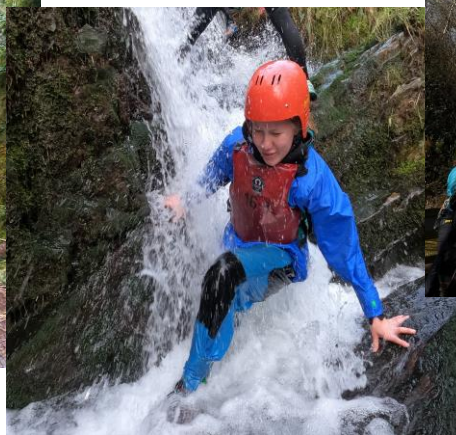

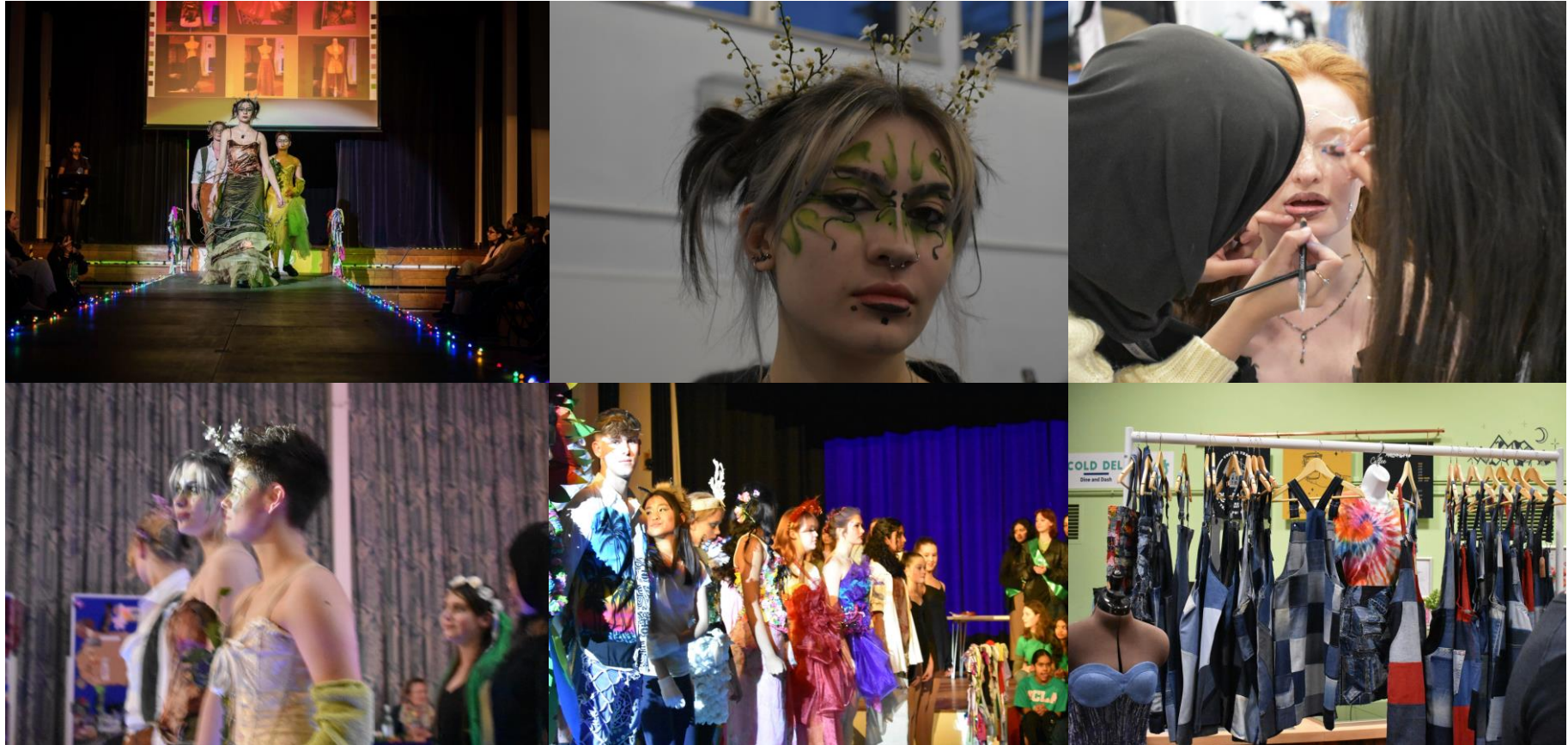

Sustainable Fashion Style

Students are hitting the catwalk with Sustainable Fashion Shows this Spring, upcycling and upstyling outfits donated to our shops, and raising funds for the charity.

Aylesbury High School students have been repurposing some of our donated clothing donations into new outfits as part of their inter-school Art competition which will culminate in a fundraising Fashion Show in March. They will also be operating a donation station on the night, encouraging other students and parents to donate their preloved clothes and get involved with the sustainable fashion movement.



Eleven students from **Aylesbury College** have been volunteering in our shops all across the county as part of their Fashion, Beauty & Communications course, and collecting donated outfits to restyle and sell at their Fashion Show. The students will also be running a pop-up shop at the event to raise funds – last year's event raised over £1,000!
