Dear Parents/Carers,

YEAR 9 MATHEMATICS VISIT TO SILVERSTONE INTERACTIVE MUSEUM CAREERS SHOWCASE ON WEDNESDAY 1ST MAY 2024 (23-ZSILV)

The Maths department is planning to take 60 Year 9 Maths students to the Silverstone Interactive Museum to take part in a careers showcase on Wednesday 1st May at 9:00am. **Places will be on a first come, first serve basis.** The day would be attended by representatives from F1 Teams, Universities offering Motorsport higher education routes, Engineering companies and companies associated with Motorsport Logistics. A key part of the day will be a timetable of talks delivered by industry experts in these fields. Students will be departing from Turnfurlong by coach at 9:00am and returning to Turnfurlong at 3:30pm in order to catch school buses / make their own way home as usual. Four members of staff will accompany the group. Your daughter will need to bring a packed lunch.

As this visit will take place in school time, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £8.60 to cover the costs. If you would like your daughter to attend this visit, please pay via ParentMail by Monday 25 March 2024 at the latest. This trip will open on ParentMail at 19.00 on Thursday 7 March. If you are unable to find the payment item on your homepage in ParentMail you can search for the item in your shop page. To double check whether you have made a payment for this trip, go to Parent Mail, select 'Payments' on the left hand side and 'History' at the bottom of the screen. If there are insufficient contributions, this trip will not be able to run. This voluntary contribution is non-refundable unless your daughter can be replaced by another student or for cancellation due to medical reasons, confirmed by a doctor.

We would not want anyone to be unable to take part because of financial circumstances. If you would like to apply for financial support for this trip (whether or not your daughter is eligible for Pupil Premium Funding), please complete the confidential 'Request for Financial Assistance' form accessed via the Parents' section of the website by Monday 25 March. Please reference the trip code: 23-ZSILV. If neither the payment nor request for financial assistance is received by the deadline, we will assume that your daughter does not wish to attend the trip.

Consent and Medical Details

Ticking the relevant box when making payment in ParentMail constitutes consent to this activity. Please note that the student medical information and your contact details that we hold on record will be used for the trip, so if anything has changed since you last updated us, please email the changes to your daughter's Pastoral Support Assistant.
