KS2 Reading and Phonics



Our whole school focus this year is to support our children to become fluent readers. What do we mean by fluency? In the context of literacy, reading fluency is defined as reading with accuracy (reading words correctly), automaticity (reading words at an appropriate speed without great effort) and prosody (appropriate stress and intonation).

Reading at Home




With the support of their class teacher your child will be able to select their own home reading book from our school library.






