

Morning Drop Off

Please can we just remind parents that you need to wait with your child at morning drop off until the class teacher arrives on the yard at 8.40am. Once your child is with their class teacher, you are free to head off.

Just a reminder that Sports' Day will now be on Thursday 13th July. We have had a slight rethink on the timings and the event will now start at 1pm prompt and finish at 3pm. Parents are very welcome to come along and watch the event.

Medicine In School

We have had a few incidents around medication in school this week, so thought it might be a good time to remind parents of the rules around having medicine in school:



- All medicine coming into school should be brought in by an adult and handed in at the school office. If your child is at Kids Club, medicine should be handed to a staff member there who can then pass it to school staff.
- Where possible, medicine should be administered at home outside of school hours
- Before we can administer any medicine in school, we need to have an Administration of Medication Form completed and signed by the parent or carer.
- We can only administer prescribed medicine which must come into school in its original packaging including the prescription information. This information must match the form completed by the parent or carer.
- Under no circumstances should a child bring any medication into school with them. Any medication found will be removed and the parent contacted.


We appreciate that children may sometimes require non - prescribed medicine especially at this time of year with hay fever and allergies abounding, and parents are welcome to arrange to come into school to administer that medicine themselves if it is required.

MCAS Online Payments

We have had a couple of queries recently about finding payment options in MCAS as the system does not automatically show payment items on the

home screen.

Dinner money balance will show up on the main screen and can be paid by clicking on the box.

Trip voluntary contributions can be found by clicking on **TRIPS** in the menu on the left-hand side of the screen - this should show any upcoming trips for your child. Click on the trip you require and it will take you to the payment screen.

All other payment items such as milk, music, swimming, Father's Day lunches etc can be found by clicking on **PRODUCTS** in the menu on the left-hand side of the screen and selecting the item you would like to pay.
