Our uniform consists of:

- White shirt or polo shirt
- Blue jumper or cardigan (embodied with logo or plain)
- Grey trousers
- Grey skirt
- Grey pinafore dress
- Grey school shorts (Summer term)
- Blue and white check summer dress
 -(Summer term)
- White/grey or black socks or tights
- Black school shoes (flat black boots may be worn in the colder months)
- School book bag (not backpack or rucksack)
- School fleece body warmer (optional)

Jewellery:

Jewellery may not be worn in school for health and safety reasons, this includes earrings. An inexpensive watch may be worn for school, but please note school cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage. This watch should not be a smart watch.

Hair:

All long hair should be tied back. Any hair accessories (including hairbands/bobbles etc) should be kept to a minimum.

Exceptions:

We recognise that at times, children cannot wear the required uniform because it does not agree with their sensory needs. In this instance, we will look at solutions and alternatives on an individual basis to ensure all pupils are comfortable and ready to learn at school.
